The 3 Committees have been very active -among others-, in the configuration of Jurys for the different RSAI Awards (Honours and D&I Committees), the rewriting of the Jean Paelinck Award (Honours Committee) and the advertisement of RSAI events in social media (Communications Committee)

The Communications Committee has been given the long-term task of checking the state of the web pages of the national sections included in the supranational they represent

4. Confirmation of the approval of the new text for the 2025 Jean Paelinck Award (Annex IV)

RSAI Executive Director Ana Viñuela informs that after receiving several emails regarding rules, deadline (non-existent until now), etc, for the Jean Paelinck Award, the Honours Committee was given the specific aim to review its written rules. The new text suggested and agreed by the Honours Committee consists basically on minor modifications of the previous text and the addition of specific information on the deadline: May 31st of the year of the Award. This new text circulated by email among the RSAI Council members (and LRPC) for their approval (email sent 4th April 2025).

After a discussion about the “near retirement” eligibility for this Award (with participation of Katarzina Kopczewska, Heynes Hingsley, Roberta Capello, Andrea Caragliu and Sebastian Bourdien), it is agreed that the new text will say “Normally the recipient of this Award would be nearing retirement or be formally retired (over 60), but still be active as a contributor to scholarship in Regional Science”.

The new text is considered approved by the RSAI Council as there were no objections to it.

5. Discussion about the need for a new text for the Peter Nijkamp RSAI Research Encouragement Award (for a mid-career scholar from a developing country) (Annex V)

RSAI Executive Director informs about several emails received from potential applicants for this Award asking for clarifications regarding:

- a) The possibility of the paper to have several authors
- b) The eligibility criteria being fulfilled by all authors (or only by the one applying for the award)
- c) The definition of what a developing nation is (according to the present text, it is the RSAI Council the one deciding what a developing nation is) and
- d) If the applicant needs to be FROM a developing nation or WORKING in an organization based in a developing nation.

The Honours Committee is working on agreeing in a new text with clear instructions regarding these issues detected for everyone (not only for the ones asking by email)

RSAI Executive Director informs that so far, members of the Honours Committee have not come to an agreement on the new text and whenever they agree on the new text, it will need to be approved by the RSAI Council, maybe during the next RSAI council meeting.

6. Confirmation of the approval of the i) 2025 Jury for the Jean Paelinck Award and ii) the 2025 Selection Committee for the RSAI Fellow Award. (Annex VI)

RSAI Executive Director reminds an email was sent 4th April 2025 to all members of the RSAI Council (with cc to the LORPC) to approve by email the composition of the *2025 Jury for the Jean Paelinck Award* and the composition of the *2025 Selection Committee for the RSAI Fellow Award*. Both juries/committees were previously agreed by the Honours and D&I Committees.

No objections received by email in the following two working days, so the 2025 Jury for the Jean Paelinck Award and the 2025 Selection Committee for the RSAI Fellow Award are considered approved by the RSAI Council.

7. Information on the winners of the PiRS Annual Paper Award, Martin Beckman Award. (Rosella Nicollini, EiC of PiRS, Annex VII).

PiRS EiC Rosella excused her presence. RSAI Executive Director shows her letter announcing the winner of the PiRS Annual Paper Award. On March 24th 2025 the commission composed by the RSAI Fellows Eduardo Haddad (LARSA), Janet Kohlhase (NARSC), Erik Verhoef, (ERSA) and Rosella Nicolli selected the following article as the recipient of the 2025 Martin Beckmann award: Giorgio Fazio, Sara Maioli, Nirat Rujimora, "Building back greener, levelling-up or both? An assessment of the economic and environmental efficiency transition of UK regions", Published in *Papers in Regional Science*, Volume 103, Issue 6, 2024, 100053, link: <https://www.sciencedirect.com/science/article/pii/S1056819024000733>. Giorgio Fazio has informed he will be attending ERSA 2025 in Athens to receive the Award

8. Information about the winners of the RSPP Annual Paper Award, and the RSPP Special Issue Award (Andrea Caragliu, EiC of RSPP, Annex VIII)

RSPP EiC Andrea Caragliu informs that there will be no Special Issue Awards this year, but there were 5 competitors in the close list, all of them being good papers. The winner paper was written by Loras-Gimeno, D., Gómez-Bengoechea, G., & Díaz-Lanchas, J. (2024). Fiscal redistribution and the narrowing urban–rural income gap, published in *Regional Science Policy & Practice*, 16(5), 100045. Link: <https://doi.org/10.1016/j.rspp.2024.100045>. Andrea Caragliu explains the main findings of this paper and that all member of the Committee concurred on the good quality of the paper. (Committee was made up of Denise Pumain (ERSA), Kara Kockelman (NARSC), Carlos Azzoni (LARSA), and Neil Reid (NARSC))

The winners have informed about their willingness to receive the RSPP Best Paper Award in ERSA 2025 (Athens).

9. Report and accounts of 2024

(Andrea Caragliu, Annex IX)

Andrea Caragliu, acting as previous RSAI Executive Director, explains what is the-pretty solid in his opinion, situation of RSAI before moving into the new management. Nevertheless, the synthetic report underlines two issues related to the transition from Wiley to Elsevier, ie from regular subscription to gold access based system.

- i) This transition implies a big change in revenues: from flat revenues plus a proportion of profits (with Wiley) to a fully revenue-profit based where RSAI revenues increase with the number of articles published (with Elsevier); and also
- ii) This transition meant also a change on when the funds are transferred from the editorial to RSAI. With Wiley RSAI would have 85% of expected revenues at the beginning of the fiscal year and then RSAI would have the rest of the balance at the beginning of the next year; while with Elsevier the first payment happens before April 30th (that is the deadline) and the payments are based on the projections from negotiations from 2 years ago, which imply increasing both journals in size.

As a consequence, Andrea Caragliu remarks that there are no monetary problems in the short run -basically because last year's World Congress was a big success-, but RSAI's revenues from journals are expected to go down with the new contract, at least in the short run.

10. RSAI Bank Accounts 2025

(Annex X)

RSAI Executive Director informs about the accounts collected by RSAI Secretariat for 2025. Some RSAI sections have already paid while others not and right now the year figure is negative, as it is expected to be at the end of the year. Nevertheless, there is enough money in RSAI to keep on going for several years even with yearly losses. Expected income from Elsevier has not yet being received and is due tomorrow. There is meeting programmed with Rose from Elsevier May 2nd.

The accounts circulated show the normal expenses related of the Association in 2025

RSAI Executive Director informs about 2 big changes related to the accounts:

- 500k of the RSAI money is now in a risk-free deposit account. A yield of 2.900 € for 3 months (2,397€ after taxes) can be seen already in the accounts. This risk free deposit will be renewed every 3-6 months. Interests are expected to decrease in Europe. The decision to open this free-deposit account was taken after consultation with the RSAI Financial Officer and always making sure to have enough operative money in RSAI.
- The RSAI secretariat, Elisabete Martins, has suggested that the monetary value (when existing) of all the RSAI Awards should all be in EUROS as the RSAI accounts are in euros every time and to avoid the inconvenience of doing a transfer without knowing the final quantity awarded by RSAI (due to exchange rate fluctuations). The Honours Committee agrees with the proposed change to euros.

Building Bridges Program changes from 500 US\$ to 500 €. The Martin Beckmann RSAI Annual Award (PIRS): From 500 pounds sterling to 750 €. Czamanski Dissertation Award is 1000 US\$ (but we can leave it as it is as the money does not come from RSAI accounts)

Changes are considered approved by RSAI Council.

11. Updates on the RSAI World Congress: organization, confirmation of dates, mobilization of networks, organization's suggestions for keynote speakers and members of the scientific committee. Issues. (Carolina Guevara, Annex XI)

Carolina Guevara, member of the LOC for the 2026 RSAI World Congress, presents the advances of the 2026 RSAI World Congress. Firstly, Carolina talks about Quito, describing it as an attractive and safe city. After talking about the Congress venue (Escuela Politecnica Nacional, with very well-equipped buildings) and the hotels around that have been negotiated with preferential fees, Carolina focuses on information on how to get to Quito, information on accommodation, visa requirements, practical information, tourism information (all will be published in the web page of the RSAI World Congress).

Finally Carolina focuses on the Schedule (abstract submission, registration and so on). The RSAI World Congress will take place May 27th to May 29th.

Carolina confirms the presence of Carlos Moreno as Keynote speaker invited by the LOC. She also suggests the involvement of national sections to organize Special Sessions in the RSAI World Congress and to have the presence of all national sections from Latinoamerica (organizing a Special Session on Sustainable Development in Latin America)

Carolina suggests more names for keynote speakers.

Carolina Guevara focuses now on the title of the RSAI World Congress ("Wellbeing and sustainability, Regional Science Discussions at the Earth's Core") and its different themes. She also explains that the LOC is trying to get local financial support from entities such as the Municipality of Quito and the University itself.

After checking the schedule proposed (which is the standard for the RSAI World Congress) Sebastian Bourdien manifests being worried about having keynote speakers at the same time as parallel sessions.

RSAI Executive Director remarks that it is RSAI's responsibility to choose the keynote speaker, so the list of keynote speakers shown are just suggestions by the LOC.

12. RSAI Programs: the Nurturing New Talent Program (NNT) and Building Bridges Program

A/ NNT Program
B/ Building Bridges Program

(Annex XII and XIII)

RSAI Executive Director remarks that both the Nurturing New Talent Program (NNT) and the Building Bridges Program depend directly on RSAI (and therefore RSAI Council), not on any Committee. And there is need to talk about them, and maybe solving some issues online and some others later on.

Regarding the BB program, after checking the records RSAI Executive Director explains that few people apply every year (in 2024 one applicant from India to attend ERSA; in 2023, 3 applicants from India to attend NARSC, ERSA and PRSCO; in 2022 and 2021 zero applications; in 2020 there were 24 applicants from Morocco to attend RSAI Conference in Morocco; in 2019 zero applications; and in 2018 there were 17 applicants to attend the RSAI conference in Goa, India).

RSAI have 5,000 euros to help researchers to attend supranational or RSAI conferences and we (RSAI Council) need to think on how to help.

The BB Program is right now not used that much (maybe because it is not known, because of the eligibility criteria, because the monetary help is not enough, etc). RSAI Council is invited to think about reforming this RSAI Program and in any case before 2026 RSAI World Congress in Quito (to try to reach researchers from LatinAmerica). Just a remark: according to the eligibility criteria only few countries from Latinoamerica can apply to the BB Program.

Then RSAI Executive Director moves on to the Nurturing New Talent Program (NNT) which is open all year and aims to promote Regional Science events in different parts of the world. The issue detected in this NNT program is related to the deadline. Events taking place in the second half of 2025 should have applied before October 2024.

Two applications were received at the beginning of 2025 for events taking place at the end of 2025 (June for Colombia and October for Armenia). RSAI Executive Director suggests a change in the text (to be probably discussed in the next RSAI Council) and asks RSAI Council for the approval of those 2 late applicants (as there is money left from both LARSA -no application last year, and PRSCO).

Prof. Hindley agrees with all the proposals. Hidehiko Kanegae asks about the NNT funding for Sri Lanka and RSAI Executive Director informs that there is still money after funding the Sri Lanka workshop. Prof. Azzoni agrees with Hindley: accepting those two late applications and also on working on how to have a more dynamic way to apply and approve proposals through the NNT Program.

Prof. Haifeng remarks the difficulties of the committees for evaluating the applications for the NNT Program if it is an open call. Prof. Lise Bourdeau-Lepage underlines that if accepting these two late proposal, we should launch an overall call for fairness and that we need to change the rules and have two selection periods.

For the request of accepting these two late applications for the NNT program, the RSAI council approves. For the request of changing the text of the NNT program, just adding a

sentence saying “late applications will be considered only if there is money left for this RSAI Program”, the RSAI Council approves.

For the suggestion for changing the rules for the NNT program for a more dynamic way to fund these initiatives (more just-in-time), the RSAI Council agrees and the new text will be dealt with in forthcoming meetings.

No more comments or questions.

13. Report on PRSCO Restructuring Committee (Hiroyuki Shibusawa, Annex XIV)

RSAI President reports on the ongoing PRSCO Restructuring meetings. So far there were two meetings. RSAI President reminds the Council when the Committee was created and what was its purpose. In the first meeting (online in November 2024) of the Restructuring Committee, a new potential structure of PRSCO was discussed, including the creation of a new Asian Association. After members of this Committee shared their view on the potential structure and future directions, the historical background of PRSCO is remarked and also the relevance of collaborating.

January 2025 was set as the deadline to send proposals, and right after (February 2025), the second Restructuring PRSCO Committee meeting took place (online). Two proposals were received: one from South Korea and another from China.

The Korean proposal was presented by Prof. Kwon Park (Chinese member did not attend) and discussed in detail. The proposal suggests a change on the name, from PRSCO to PARSA (Pacific Asian Regional Science Association) and the possibility to split in the long run into two separate association. Several members supported this proposal, which means keeping the present structure. More engagement from China and India is suggested, being those 2 sections/countries key focus in the next meeting in May.

Prof. Kwon Park underlines that his proposal was depending on China’s presentation. The present name (PRSCO) works well as it is, and only if China joins, he proposes the new name.

Prof. Kingsley agrees with the general idea of having China and India in the future in a Continental area group (and other countries), but in the future. At present we should keep with the ongoing PRSCO program until they are solid enough to split into their own cluster.

Prof. Kingsley supports Park’s view in this regard.

Award honoring Jean Paelinck, one of the four founding Fellows of RSAI

2025 Jean Paelinck RSAI Award for Distinguished Sustained Scholarship in Regional Science Methods

DEADLINE to RECEIVE NOMINATIONS: May 31st 2025.

1. Goal

1.1 The “Jean Paelinck Award for Distinguished Sustained Scholarship in Regional Science Methods” recognizes and honors the truly outstanding scholarly achievement of a senior and internationally recognized regional scientist in the field of Regional Science Methods. Such an achievement should be recognized from an early stage in a recipient’s academic career and be sustained throughout the duration of their career.

1.2 The Award celebrates that career and recognizes the attainment of outstanding scholarly excellence in contributing to innovation in the development of Regional Science Methods.

2. The Award

2.1 The *Jean Paelinck Award for Distinguished Scholarship in Regional Science Methods* is established to recognize and honor the distinguished scholarly career of Jean Paelinck, one of the four foundation Fellows of RSAI.

2.2 The Award will be given periodically (every odd year) by the RSAI Council, and is recognized as one of the highest honors bestowed by RSAI.

3. Eligibility

3.1 The *Jean Paelinck Award for Distinguished Sustained Scholarship in Regional Science Methods* may only be awarded to a regional scientist who has already been recognized for his/her scholarly excellence.

3.2 Normally the recipient of this Award would be nearing retirement or be formally retired, but still be active as a contributor to scholarship in Regional Science.

4. Nomination and Process for Making the Award

4.1 Nominations or consideration for the *Jean Paelinck Award for Distinguished Sustained Scholarship in Regional Science Methods* will be solicited every two (2) years.

4.3 A nomination for consideration for the *Jean Paelinck Award for Distinguished Sustained Scholarship in Regional Science Methods* comes from RSAI Fellows. The criteria to be addressed in nominating a candidate should include -among others-, the following: demonstration of early career scholarly contribution, sustained continuing scholarly contribution, international impact, inter-generational impacts (students and colleagues), impact on other related areas to regional science.

4.4 A nomination must be accompanied by testimonials from a minimum of five (5) eminent scholars from at least three (3) nations who are able to verify the importance and scholarly standing and importance of the nominee's publications. Nominations may remain active for five (5) years.

4.6 The nomination and supporting documents are to be sent to the Executive Director of RSAI who will then forward them to the members of a Selection Jury. Deadline to receive the nomination and supporting documents will be May 31st of the year of the Award.

4.7 The Selection Jury comprises a Chair (selected by the RSAI Council, and who is a member of the RSAI Long Range Planning Committee), plus four (4) RSAI Fellows. A Chair's tenure is limited to two (2) selection processes. Two (2) RSAI Fellow members of the Selection Jury rotate off every two (2) years.

4.8 When the Selection Jury recommends someone for the Award, the Executive Director will inform the RSAI Council in writing of the nominee. Unless within fourteen (14) days more than one-third of the members of the RSAI Council advise the Executive Director in writing of their dissent regarding the nomination, then the RSAI President or Executive Director will write to the nominee and invite him/her to accept the Award.

4.9 The presentation of the *Jean Paelinck Award for Distinguished Sustained Scholarship in Regional Science Methods* will take place at one of the RSAI supra-regional meetings (NARSC/RSAmericas, ERSA, PRSCO), or at the RSAI World Congress.

5. The Award

5.1 The *Jean Paelinck Award for Distinguished Lifelong Scholarship in Regional Science Methods* will consist of a framed certificate containing the words “The Jean Paelinck Award for Distinguished Sustained Scholarship in Regional Science Methods.”

5.2 The certificate will include the RSI logo and the name of the Award, and a citation outlining the recipient’s scholarly achievement and the reasons why the Award is being made.

ANNEX V Discussion about the need for a new text for the Peter Nijkamp Research Encouragement Award

We need to have in mind the goal of the PN Award, that states: *"The Award recognizes the outstanding potential of an mid-career researcher from a nation in the developing world and in which there is a formal Section of RSAI, and seeks to encourage the development of the early career scholar as a high quality researcher in the field of Regional Science and as a participant in the international Regional Science community"*.

It can also be read the following: *"Eligibility to apply for the Award is restricted to **mid-career researchers**, defined as person in full time employment in either a teaching or a research position in a university or research institution **in a developing nation in which there is a member section of RSAI**, and who has held their doctoral qualification for no more than ten (10) years as at the 31 December in the year in which they apply for the Award*.

The Honours Committee has detected eligibility problems mainly related to co-authorship and country eligibility of author or authors.

Using the time-length in relation to the Thesis defense is a good criteria to define a "mid career researcher" but issues arise when reading about two different criteria for the country: "researcher from a nation in the developing world" vs researcher working "in a university or research institution in a developing nation".

Q1/Which eligible criteria to follow? Researcher from a developing country or researcher working in a developing country or both?

Also, the Honours Committee shows its concerns about the criteria **"the country having an RSAI section"**. Lots of "developing countries" do not have a national RSAI Section and if someone from a developing country finds out about this Award and wins, it would be a great chance to start working on the creation of a RSAI Section in that country (through or thanks to the awardee).

Q2/ Should eligible countries have an RSAI Section or not?

Things become even more complex in case of co-authorship. The PN Award means to recognize the *outstanding potential of one person, a mid-career researcher from a nation in the developing world*. Although the most relevant document should be his/her CV, the basis for the PN Award ask also for "a research paper that will be considered for publication in PiRS". Given that, by definition, the mid-career researcher is at the beginning of his/her research career, it would not be a surprise that papers are written in collaboration with other seniors (for instance his/her PhD supervisor).

Q3/ The Award is to recognize the potential of one person based on his/her CV and a research paper. Should all co-authors of the research paper fulfill the criteria of being a mid-career researcher from a nation in the developing world or just the one applying for the PN Award?

In relation to eligible countries, the Honours Committee reckons that the criteria cannot be "the countries that the Council decides". The Honours Committee believes that it should applied the same applied used for the RSAI conference fees which is the World Bank classification, in "Poor Countries"; "Lower-Middle Income Countries" (and Upper-Middle Countries and so on)

Q4/ What "nation of the developing world" means for this Award? Just "Poor countries" and "Lower-Middle Income countries"? Or also the Upper-Middle Countries?

In the list below (updated World Bank list), marked in yellow you can see the countries that were considered eligible for the PN Award in the past years. As it can be seen, the country selection criteria has been unclear. Also in ***italics*** those “poor countries” and “lower middle income countries” with RSAI national sections.

Motivation:

This contribution tackles the relevant and open question of the implementation of effective policies to achieve two goals at regional level: “building back greener” and “levelling-up”. The approach implemented by the authors is empirical. The setting of reference is the UK regions for the period 2005-2020 and their study relies on an original data sample. The research strategy exploits the Data Envelopment Analysis (DEA) to calculate the regional and environmental efficiency, whereas the computation of the Markov transition probabilities is meant to quantify the regional transition probabilities to improve at least one the two previous efficiencies. Results emphasize that there is a trade-off between the two types of efficiencies for more than half of the regions and that the costs of transition are unequally distributed. Authors also identify that regions are more likely to become efficient in both directions if they are already environmentally efficient. Furthermore, the empirical analysis does not provide evidence of spatial spillovers for the environmental transition process, but they matter for regional economic efficiency. The final discussion of this contribution is timely and relevant to inspire effective regional policies. Evidence at hand suggests that there is a clear need of strong coordination between place-based policy and national governments to fully achieve the two selected goals.

ANNEX VIII. Letter by RSPP EiC Andrea Caragliu announcing the winner of the RSPP best paper published in 2024

This year, the RSPP Best Paper award goes to

Loras-Gimeno, D., Gómez-Bengoechea, G., & Díaz-Lanchas, J. (2024). Fiscal redistribution and the narrowing urban–rural income gap. *Regional Science Policy & Practice*, 16(5), 100045.

The Committee, made up of Denise Pumain (ERSA), Kara Kockelman (NARSC), Carlos Azzoni (LARSA), and Neil Reid (NARSC), evaluated five very good papers selected by the RSPP EiC, Andrea Caragliu.

The winner was chosen because of its touching upon two very relevant topics for the regional science policy literature, viz. (i.) the role of agglomeration economies in driving territorial income imbalances, and (ii.) whether policies should target territories, rather than individuals.

The paper originally exploits Spanish micro data to show that, in a low density context, the urban-rural income gap decreases as a result of fiscal interventions, while also documenting relevant spatial heterogeneity in the gaps across Spanish regions.

These results offer a significant contribution to the regional science literature dealing with the role of national and regional policies in shaping local welfare levels.

Note from the Executive Director in 2024

In 2024 three RSAI Council Meetings have been held. The meetings were at RSAI world congress in Kecskemét, Hungary; the ERSa conference in Angra do Heroísmo, Portugal; and the NARSC conference in New Orleans, LA.

In 2024, the RSAI Council composition changed as follows:

- Hiroyuki Shibusawa was appointed as RSAI Vice-President;
- In-Kwon Park replaced Hidehiko Kanegae as PRSCO President
- Hidehiko Kanegae replaced Lily Kiminami as PRSCO Representative
- Haifeng Qian replaced Daoqin Tong as NARSC Representative
- Roberta Capello replaced André Torre as ERSa President
- Fernando Perobelli replaced Serena Erendira Serrano Oswald as LARSA Representative
- Camilla Lenzi, André Chagas and Katarzyna Kopczewska replaced Isabelle Thomas, Jouke Van Dijk and Rosella Nicolini as Councillors at large.

During 2024, the activities of the three most recently activated committees (Diversity and inclusion committee; Communication committee; Honors committee) carried on. Across all committees, a better effort in coordinating activities, and in carrying out their mandates, would be welcome, as often the ED and the president had to remind the committees of their duties and schedule.

2024 was also characterized by witnessed growth in terms of scientific reputation of our journals. The IF of 2024 has not yet been released, but for *Papers in Regional Science's* the CiteScoreTracker 2024 is 4.8, whereas in 2023 it was equal to 4.4. For *Regional Science Policy and Practice*, the CiteScoreTracker 2024 is 3.7, whereas in 2023 it was equal to 3.6. To both EiCs, Prof. Rosella Nicolini and prof. Tomaz Dentinho, the Council's thank-you for their great job. Last but not least, Mina Akharvan and Martijn Smit edited two issues of the RSAI Newsletter, published and distributed online by the RSAI in May and November 2024.

In terms of publications, the main event made in 2023 was the decision to transition from Wiley to Elsevier, and from hybrid to Gold Open Access for both PiRS and RSPP. The decision became effective as of Jan. 1, 2024. While the final outcomes of this transition will be monitored over the next years, and the early findings commented in the 2025 ED report, we can already state this was a bold move, made by the Council to try and anticipate the market, and offer our membership impactful and solid scientific journals. For the time being, early evidence suggests that (i.) the decrease in submissions to both journal was not as bad as expected, and typical in similar transitions; (ii.) The publication of a number of papers lower than the forecasts produced by Elsevier in the negotiation period, and the higher share of waived paper w.r.t. the same assumptions, led to an expected (and, hopefully, temporary) decrease in revenues for the Association w.r.t. the previous, subscription-based contract. This calls for reflections on the way the new contract must be embraced by our association, and a clear message to all members that the transition comes with costs, along with the undeniable benefits stemming from universal open access, leading to expected increases in our journal's impact.

The RSAI World Congresses was held in Kecskemét, Hungary, with the support of the LOC (John Von Neumann University), and the RSAI's Hungarian Section, MRTT. The congress was a success (see point 4 for more information).

The Association gained further in the rebound to the record of individual members achieved a few years ago, and following the substantial decrease in members after the Pandemic hit. Members remained roughly constant, moving from 4,222 in 2023 to 4,198 in 2024. While the association is holding positions, a note on some troublesome sections (in terms of lack of activities, delayed or missing payments, and difficult communications) is worth being discussed at future Council meetings.

In 2024 the Nurturing Talent programme funded the following initiatives:

- 2nd workshop on Sustainable regional development in Central Asia, May 6–7, 2024, Samarkand, Uzbekistan;
- 1st SOCHER Summer school: “Measuring Regional disparities: spatial methods and applications”, December 10-11, 2024 University of Concepción Campus Chillán;
- The 2nd International Workshop on Rethinking the Regional Development Opportunities and Challenges in Southern Africa in Southern Africa, 19-20 June 2024 | Maputo, Mozambique;
- ERSa Summer School 2024. Quantitative Methods Addressing Geographical Imbalances: New Techniques, Frameworks and Applications 3-7 June 2024, Oviedo, Spain.

In 2024, the net profit for the exercise was equal to € 46,143.48. The Association’s Bank Account availability increased from € 582,157.66 (brought forward from 2023) to € 622,329.93 as of Dec. 31, 2024. While the situation does remain florid for the accounts of the association, leaving enough cushion for a prolonged period of financial restraints (if any), two items deserve in my view the council’s attention: (i.) Some national sections tend to be difficult to reach, and provide belated payment, if any; some are in fact rather inactive, and the Council should in my view consider to eliminate them from the map and start all over again; (ii.) National sections payments are almost never sufficient for fully covering the expenses for all activities. A substantial portion of the Association revenues comes from the contract with the publisher, whose renewal is a crucial step for the association’s finances, beyond its scientific activity. For 2024, since revenues from the new Elsevier contract will only land in 2025, and 2024 only comprises a tiny fraction of the leftover from the Wiley contract, most of the increase in the association’s financial availability comes from the revenues of the World Congress.

To conclude, I would like to thank the whole RSAI Council, the Long-Range Planning Committee, and the Council-appointed committees for their continuous support of RSAI activities. The Association keeps growing, and while it does face many challenges (in the publication landscape; in the relations with national and supranational sections; in terms of competition with other associations gathering members from germane disciplines), its truly global membership; its sense of belonging; and the quality of its members and representatives all bode well for successfully dealing with them.

The motivation provided by the committee reads as follows:

Professor André Torre has been active in the regional science community for almost four decades. He has been President (2019- 2023) and Vice-President (2014-2018) of the ERSA as well as a member of the ERSA Council (2009-2011) and the European Organizing Committee (2014-2019) and from 2009-2011, President of the French Speaking Section of ERSA (ASRDLF). He was Chair of the Local Organizing Committee for the 47th ERSA Congress, in 2007 in Paris (Local governance and sustainable development), and the main organizer of the 60th ERSA Congress, in 2021, online (Territorial Futures – Visions and scenarios for a resilient Europe). For a long period, he has also served as a member of the RSAI Council. He also lent his leadership skills in various editorial capacities and in steering conferences, workshops, summer schools, and symposia in Europe and beyond. His long and dedicated work for regional science at the highest levels makes him a worthy recipient of the Kohno Award.

[Felix Pot](#) is chosen as the winner of the RSAI dissertation award in 2024 for his work 'The Extra Mile: Perceived Accessibility in Rural Areas'.

The dissertation presents a novel conceptual and methodological approach to the analysis of perceived accessibility and it shows that a lower provision of services and amenities in rural areas does not necessarily translate to lower levels of perceived accessibility compared to urban areas. The research employs both quantitative and qualitative methods to examine perceived accessibility to daily activities in rural areas in the Netherlands, contributing to the normative evaluation of spatial inequalities in accessibility. The PhD dissertation includes chapters that are already published in high quality peer-reviewed international journals, including highly cited articles in the Journal of Transport Geography.

4. RSAl World Congress

Summary of the conference objectives and methodology

Between the 8th and the 11th of April, 2024, the world Regional Science community gathered at John von Neumann University in Kecskemét, Hungary, for the 14th edition of the world congress of the Regional Science Association International (RSAl). More than 50 countries' representatives joined to discuss their latest results and share opinion at the multi- disciplinary area of regional growth, economics, environment and geography. The congress was organized by the Hungarian Section of the Regional Science Association International (MRTT), jointly with John Von Neumann University and the RSAl staff.

The meeting was open to the world-wide regional science community and brought together the key elements of multidisciplinary regional science research, while also providing a scientific platform for presenting and discussing research at the frontiers of spatial sciences. Topics covered in the conference included agglomeration economies, urban-rural relations, migration, spatial and resources allocation, border effects, urbanization, sustainable cities, mobility, land use, environmental quality, disaster management, energy transition, cultural heritage, poverty, segregation, and spatial modelling.

The organizing committee made an effort to invite a diverse (from the disciplinary, geographical, and gender angle) pool of great keynote speakers. Paper presentations have been arranged so as to maximize the time for presentation and allowing for a safe cushion for discussing results. The organizing committee aimed at avoiding the feeling of rushing to conclusions, due to the overcrowding of papers, that many academics have experienced in other events. The LOC also organized interesting opportunities to maximize publication chances, with a number of special issues dedicated to selected papers in both Hungarian and international journals.

To help disseminate the great role played by great Hungarian scholars, the LOC has temporarily dedicated conference rooms to great Hungarian regional scientists, as this was also an opportunity for the Hungarian section (MRTT) of the RSAl to showcase its great contributions to the scientific debate.

The location of the conference was chosen, following the mandate of the World Congresses of the RSAl, in order to (i.) guarantee, possibly inexpensive, accessibility to the broadest possible international audience, and (ii.) to be as close as possible to the Balkans, where the presence of the RSAl is still relatively weaker. Promising developments also spurred by the conference relate to the potential formation of a Serbian and an Albanian section.

Lastly, the conference was organized with a substantial cooperation with JRC. The cooperation translated both in financial support, which was fundamental in guaranteeing its financial sustainability, as well as in scientific collaboration. The latter, in particular, helped the Association build impactful policy sessions, also with the contribution of the other main policy body sponsors, which attracted the interest of border cooperation authorities, local boards, and European MPs.

Overall conclusions on contributions to relevant literature/empirical evidence on territorial dynamics

The conference programme highlighted the portfolio of scientific research that the international community is presently focusing on. Papers delved mostly on interregional migration, also with a specific focus on refugees; methodological aspects in empirical regional science; local public finance; regional innovation processes; real estate and housing; regional and urban policies; sustainable regional development; and climate change.

Moreover, bottom-up special session proposals included topics such as regional impacts of the restructuring of Global Value Chains; regional tourism determinants; urban creativity; borders and borderlands; well-being; and the impact of climate change on sustainable urban development.

All in all, these sessions provided a complex mosaic of a lively scientific debate on territorial aspects, coming from different disciplines, and converging on the need for a better understanding of the structural determinants of regional socio-economic development, of regional and urban inequalities, and on the territorial impacts of challenges characterizing the present geopolitical context.

Key messages from the discussion in plenary and parallel sessions

The World congress included four international keynote speakers and two Hungarian ones. Among the former, vast crowds joined discussions provided by Sarah A. Low, University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign, USA, who delivered a keynote address on “Engagement and Collaboration: Community-framed research for rural resiliency in the face of climate change”; by Eduardo Haddad, University of Sao Paulo, Brazil, on “Modeling Spatial and Economic Impacts of Disasters”; by Hee-Jung Jun, Sungkyunkwan University, Korea, on “Urban Housing Development in Korea from a Comparative Perspective”; and by Özge Öner, University of Cambridge, UK, on “Mapping the Divide: Navigating the Microgeography and Geography of Polarisation and Discontent”.

Among Hungarian speakers, Balázs Lengyel, ELKH Centre for Economic and Regional Studies, Hungary, delivered a keynote speech on “Small worlds of regional development”, while József Popp, John von Neumann University, and regular member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, addressed the crowd at the closing ceremony with his speech on “The Circular Economy and Regional Aspects”.

The policy semi-plenary sessions in the conference also addressed key topics in the scientific and policy debate in the field of regional science. A joint JRC-OECD Science for Policy Session focused on issues in collecting data and interpreting them by means of advanced techniques, including machine learning and AI, with the title “Novelties in data, novelties in methods: What's new, what's next”. This session was particularly relevant for the current scientific debate in applied regional science, as interpreting the complex outcomes that keep being strained by geopolitical tensions needs more updated methodologies, capable of adjusting almost in real time with these changes.

A second policy session was organized by the OECD on a trend that is visible in general all over Europe, but is particularly relevant for the Central and Eastern European Countries, viz. population decline. The session was entitled “Shrinking Smartly – Managing Population Decline in Cities and Regions”, and offered insight into how European economies need to adjust structurally to such demographic trends, and reshape expectations and structural relations, especially in non-tradable industries, where the role of the labor force is more difficult to replace.

A third impactful policy session was organized by the European Commission’s DG Regio, and dealt with “Cohesion Policy’s contribution for solving legal obstacles in Cross-Border regions”. Despite decades of history of progressive European integration, the European Union’s internal borders are still characterized by substantial obstacles that need to be progressively abated if European countries really want to achieve full integration. The session comprised an academic presentation, discussing a research programme on the quantification of the extent of economic costs of borders, followed by two speeches by DG management, one discussing the role of Cohesion Policy in solving border obstacles, and the future of Cohesion, the other showcasing what B-solutions can – and did – for removing obstacles between EU border regions. The session concluded with an intervention discussing a new EU Regulation to Facilitate Cross-Border Solutions.

Summary of the 1st Meeting

Quick recap

The meeting focused on discussing the restructuring of the Pacific Regional Science Conference Organization (PRSCO) and the potential formation of a new Asia-Pacific Regional Science Association. Participants shared their roles and responsibilities, proposed ideas for the new organization's structure and name, and discussed the timeline for submitting proposals and holding future meetings. The group also touched on PRSCO's history, the need for collaboration on important documents, and the possibility of creating separate associations for Asia and the Pacific in the future.

Next steps

- Committee members to submit proposals for restructuring PRSCO to Hiroyuki by the end of January 2025.
- Hiroyuki will organize the next committee meeting in February, and will include a member from the Western Regional Science Association.

Summary

International Committee Roles and Responsibilities

The members of the meeting were In Kwon Park, Sumana Bandyopadhyay, Sun Tieshan, Budy Resosudarmo, Kingsley Haynes, and Hiroyuki Shibusawa. Budy was absent. We waited for Sumana to join us for a while, but the meeting was held without her. Ana also participated as an observer as the incoming Executive Director of RSAI.

PRSCO Restructuring Committee and Options

In this meeting, Hiroyuki explains the role and objectives of the PRSCO Restructuring Committee. The committee aims to discuss possible organizational forms for regional science associations in the Asia-Pacific region and present a future vision to a new organization. Hiroyuki proposes several options for the name of the potential new association, such as the Asia-Pacific Regional Science Association or separate associations for Asia and the Pacific. He requests committee members to submit their proposals for the name and organizations by the end of January. Hiroyuki also suggests establishing a parallel committee within PRSCO to discuss its restructuring, given its 14 sections. He plans to hold several committee meetings before the next PRSCO conference in July 2025 in Sri Lanka.

Asia Pacific Association Discussion

Hiroyuki presented his summary, which included a discussion about the potential for a new association in the Asia Pacific region. Kingsley proposed the idea of keeping PRSCO the same for a couple of years or transitioning to the Asia Pacific region, with the possibility of splitting off the Asia component in the future. Kingsley suggested that the Asia Pacific Regional Science could act as an interim between the current Pacific region and a potential Asian Continental Association. In Kwon Park pointed out that the area is too large for other regional sections. At some point in the future, a decision will need to be made to separate the entire area and choose a different organization. Tieshan proposed that PRSCO could continue with its current structure for several years before becoming a larger organization involving all Asian countries. He also suggested the formation of an Asian Regional Science Association, which he planned to discuss with Paul Snow.

At this meeting, the feasibility of the proposal was discussed, while recognizing the large size and cultural differences of the Asia-Pacific region. The meeting members agreed that the status quo should be maintained, and in the future, a different situation and organization may be necessary, but concrete ideas will be considered at the next meeting.

Hiroyuki noted creating a document to store important information. He suggested sharing the document with other meetings for review if necessary.

Draft Proposal and Meeting Schedules

Hiroyuki proposed a draft proposal to be submitted by January 2025. Kingsley suggested that the proposal could be sent to Hiroyuki for review. The meeting schedule was discussed, with Hiroyuki suggesting meetings in February, May, and July. Kingsley mentioned involvement with the Western Regional Science. Hiroyuki also mentioned the need to include a new member in the meeting from the WRSA. The next meeting was tentatively set for next February.

Here are my proposals:

Based on the discussions, I would like to propose a two-phase approach to restructuring PRSCO:

1. Short-term (2-3 years): Rename PRSCO into the Pacific-Asian Regional Science Association (PARSA).

This would maintain the current organizational structure while signaling our commitment to better represent the Asia-Pacific region. The name change to PARSA would better reflect the geographical and cultural scope of our organization.

2. Long-term (5+ years): Consider splitting into two distinct organizations - one focusing on Asia and another on the Pacific region. This gradual approach would allow time to:

- Build necessary institutional capacity in both regions
- Develop separate leadership structures
- Address specific regional needs and cultural contexts
- Maintain existing relationships while fostering new ones

This approach balances the need for immediate representation with long-term organizational sustainability, while acknowledging the vast geographical and cultural differences within our current structure.

III. Membership and Governance Structure

Membership

Full Members: National or regional RSAI-affiliated organizations in Asia (e.g., Regional Science Association of China, Japan Section of the Regional Science Association International, Indian Regional Science Association, Korean Regional Science Association, etc.).

Associate Members: Institutions, universities, or individual scholars in regions without a formal RSAI section.

Observer Status: Non-Asian organizations or international bodies with interests in Asian regional science.

Governance Structure

1. **General Assembly:** The General Assembly shall be the highest decision-making body of the ARSA. It shall consist of representatives from full member organizations and individual full members. The General Assembly shall meet at least once every two years to elect the Executive Council, approve the association's budget and strategic plan, and discuss major policy issues.
2. **Executive Council:** The Executive Council shall be responsible for the day-to-day management and operation of the ARSA. It shall consist of a President, Vice-Presidents, Secretary-General, Treasurer, and other members elected by the General Assembly. The Executive Council shall meet at least once a year to discuss and decide on important matters related to the association's activities and development.
3. **Standing Committees:** The ARSA may establish standing committees, such as the Program Committee, Publication Committee, and Awards Committee, to assist the Executive Council in carrying out specific tasks and functions.
4. **Secretariat:** The Secretariat shall be responsible for the administrative and operational support of the ARSA. It shall be headed by the Secretary-General and shall include other staff members as required. The Secretariat shall be located in a suitable location in Asia, to be determined by the Executive Council.

V. Transition Plan and Preparatory Committee

2025 Q1–Q2: Form a Preparatory Committee comprising representatives from China, Japan, South Korea, India, and other interested nations.

2025 Q3–Q4: Host the First Asian Regional Science Preparatory Summit in China to draft ARSA's constitution, membership criteria, and activity roadmap.

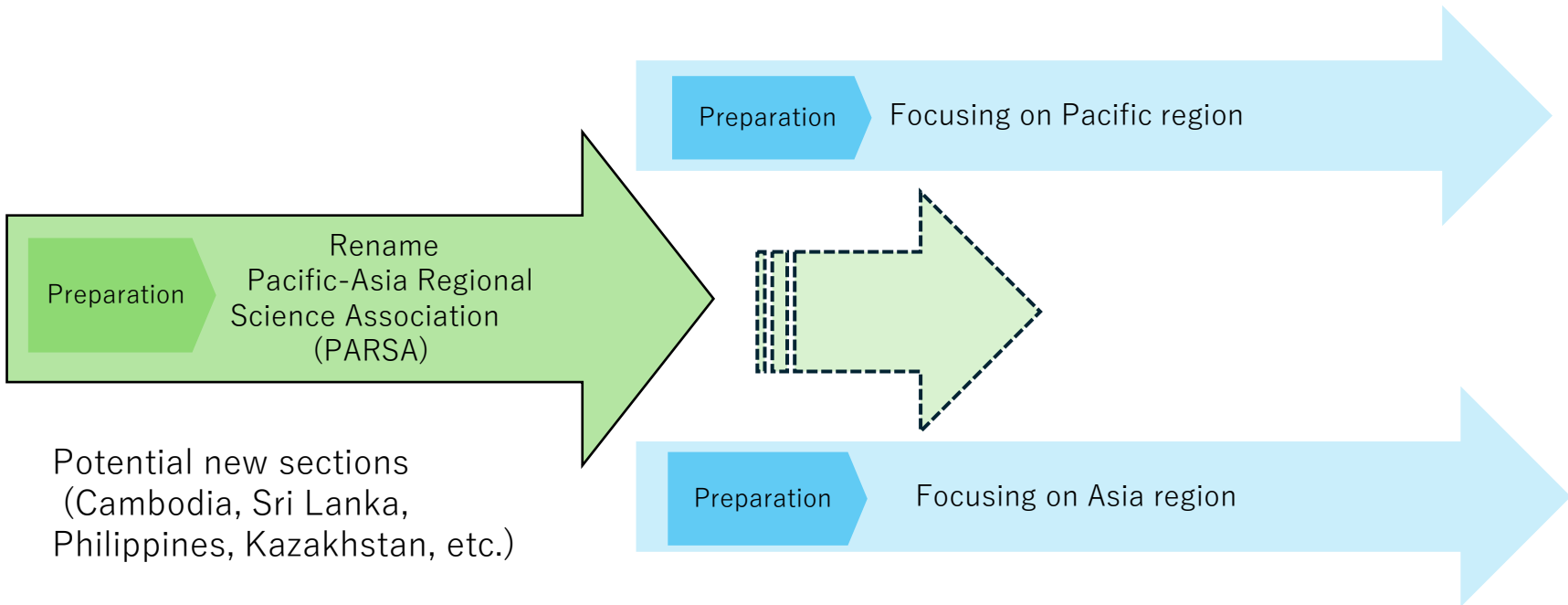
2026: Pilot activities (e.g., virtual conferences, joint research initiatives).

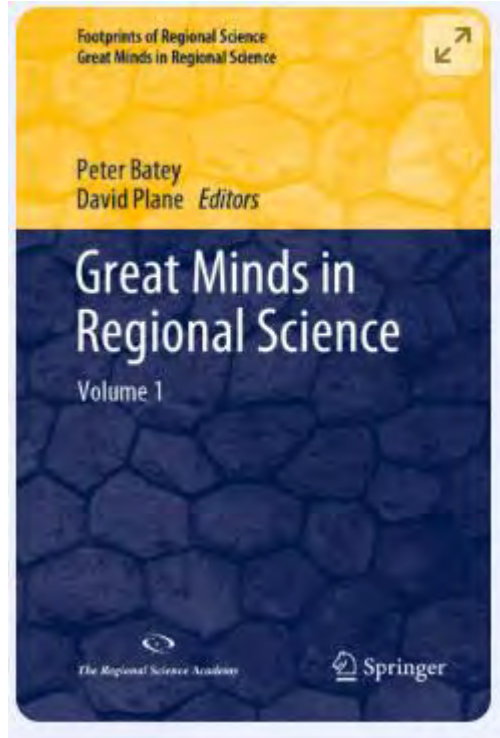
